Reverend Tony W. Latham, a native of the Eighth Episcopal District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Grenada, Mississippi, has made Florence, Alabama his home for 35 years.

Rev. Latham started his ministerial journey at Greater St. Paul A.M.E. Church in Florence under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Timothy Eric Nathan. On January 16, 2000, he preached his initial sermon, entitled "Yes Jesus Still Loves Me" I John 4:1-12. Pastor Latham attended Mississippi Valley State University - Itta Bena Mississippi, as well as the Nichols Thomas Grady School of Religion - Birmingham, Alabama.

Pastor Latham was ordained an Itinerant Deacon in October 2002 and assigned by Bishop T. Member of the Shoals Habitat for Humanity Board of Directors. Member and Spiritual Leader for the Shoals Cluster of the Alabama Emmaus Community.

Retired from 30 plus years from Lowe's Home Improvement Center, Pastor Latham is the Owner - Creative Designer of Double Ark Furniture and More, and owner of Latham Legacy Properties.
